Exhibiting loads of lavender, sweet black raspberry, cassis, licorice and garrigue-styled aromas and flavors, it shows the sweetly fruited, voluptuous 2007 style (Thierry's father claimed that he'd never seen a vintage like this). This full-bodied, concentrated and layered Chateauneuf will drink nicely through 2027.*
