**Robert Parker's Wine advocate** (Jeb Dunnuck - avr. 2017) : 90-92/100. Also deep inky colored, the 2015 Saint Chinian Clos de la Simonette (65% Mourvèdre, 20% Grenache and 15% Carignan) is slightly closed aromatically, yet has gorgeous purity, freshness and focus on the palate, with notable tannin. It reluctantly gives up pure black and blue fruits, but I'm sure it will show more character once bottled, and I suspect will keep for a decade or more. Also deep inky colored, the 2015 Saint Chinian Clos de la Simonette (65% Mourvèdre, 20% Grenache and 15% Carignan) is slightly closed aromatically, yet has gorgeous purity, freshness and focus on the palate, with notable tannin. It reluctantly gives up pure black and blue fruits, but I'm sure it will show more character once bottled, and I suspect will keep for a decade or more.
