Technical sheet written by the domaine :

Blend : It consists of a blend of 7 climates ("Les plateaux", "Les Crots", "Les Belles Croix", "Les Fleurières", "Les Brulées" and "Les Chaillots") covering an area of 3 hectares. The majority of these plots are located south of Nuits-Saint-Georges, on the lower slopes, on deep soils, a mix of clay, alluvium, and limestone pebbles. Only "Les Crots", a 1-hectare plot, is situated at the top of the slope on thin brown limestone soils.

The wine: These honest and generous wines require a few years before tasting. It is then that they will reveal their true potential!
