Attention:

The wines signed by Philippe Alliet all deserve a **decanting** a few hours before tasting, as the low level of sulfur intentionally used during vinification can sometimes lead to reduction upon opening the bottle (unpleasant aromas of cabbage, rotten egg), which of course disappears with aeration.
