Full-bodied, dense, and deep, it has a rich chassis of tannins, a fleshy core of fruit, velvety tannins, and a silky and refined character, concluding with a long, spicy, and endless finish. Though somewhat reserved at this stage, a few years of cellaring will reveal its true potential as one of the best wines of Cahors. **DRINK DATE 2024-2054.***

La Marguerite is a micro cuvée produced only since 2011, with a yield of just 2000 bottles.

**Grape variety:** 100% Malbec

**Age of the vines:** 10 years

A dual wine, both extremely silky and incredibly powerful, with remarkable concentration that is not excessive, focusing primarily on finesse. An exceptional purity of fruit (blackberry, blueberry, licorice) and an almost limitless aging potential!
