Mas Combarèla Terrasses du Larzac "Ode aux Ignorants" red 2022:

Jancis Robinson, (December 2024): 93+/100 (=16.5+/20) *“Made from 100% Carignan vines, aged 75 years, around the domaine. Certified organic. Medium purple with shading. Gamey and interesting nose. Intense fruit with a hint of spice and none of the unpleasant and harsh notes that could spoil Carignan in Languedoc. For the table. (2025-2031)”*

Guide Bettane + Desseauve 2026 (Sept. 2025): **90/100**. *“Olivier Faucon continues to amaze us with his magnificent reds, airy and of rare intensity, impressive for their fine grain and saline finishes.
