Attention:

The wines signed by Philippe Alliet all deserve a **decanting** a few hours before tasting, as the low level of sulfur intentionally used during vinification can sometimes lead to a reduction phenomenon upon opening the bottle (unpleasant aromas of cabbage, rotten egg), which of course disappears with aeration.

Grapes: single varietal, cabernet franc

Terroirs: the vieilles vignes of Philippe Alliet are between 40 and 70 years old.
