Robert Parker's Wine Advocate (Yohan Castaing, sept. 2024) : **93/100.** A blend of 40% *Clairette*, 30% *Roussanne*, 14% *Bourboulenc*, 10% *Grenache Blanc*, 2% *Picardan*, 2% *Clairette Rose* and 1% of each *Grenache Gris* and *Picpoul*, the 2023 Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc exhales a vibrant, aromatic bouquet of *lemon oil*, *spring flowers*, *honeysuckle*, *pear*, *white peach* and *spices*. Medium to full-bodied, perfectly balanced and fleshy, it's enveloping with bright acids and a long, delicate, mouthwatering finish enhanced by *menthol* notes. Matured in stainless steel (88%) and new barrels (12%) for seven months, the new oak is barely noticeable. It was derived from vines planted on six plots, all sharing the *safres* soil type.
